ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

The primary focus and content of the submitted abstract must be novel. Submission of the abstract implies that the abstract will not have been published in a scientific or professional publication prior to the presentation at the 14th Dresden Symposium on Autoantibodies.

The abstract must be informative, including a statement of the study's specific objectives, methods, summary of the results and concluding statement. Abstracts must be submitted together with a registration form of the presenting author either by e-mail to karsten.conrad@tu-dresden.de or using the online abstract form at <http://www.gfid-ev.de/dsa.htm>

The abstract handling committee (i.e. the co-chairmen and members of the international advisory board) will notify the authors regarding abstract acceptance and the form of presentation. **Authors of highly interesting abstracts will be invited to contribute a manuscript for publication in the book series "Autoantigens, Autoantibodies, Autoimmunity".**

We are proud to announce the Dresden Prize on the study of autoantibodies, which will be awarded in 2019 for the 8th time. The prize of 1000 EUR is a young scientist award (up to age 35). The members of the prize committee will select the winner by submitted abstracts as well as short presentations during the meeting.
